



Worksheet Descriptions

Clip Wsheet	Worksheet for students to use to accompany the teaching clip or as progressive examples in the classroom.
Clip Wsheet – with answers	Annotated answers to the student worksheet.
Exam Qs	A selection of exam questions from a variety of exam boards.
Exam Qs – with answers	Annotated answers to the exam questions.
MissImp Ext Wsheet	A mission impossible themed w/sheet ideal as an extension or main activity (or even homework sheet).
Whodunnit?	Activity that is usually made up of 2 documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Data sheet. This can be used as a stand-alone worksheet or used in conjunction with worksheet 2. 2. Student worksheet in which they have to evaluate statements to decide who committed the crime and where and when it happened.
Exam Question Wsheet	Exam question that includes all the major examined elements. Ideal to use as a mid lesson mini-plenary.
Exit Cards Wsheet	Worksheet that can be used as your final plenary, homework or just as a worksheet mid lesson. Includes student traffic light for them to rate their understanding.
What's the story Wsheet	A follow me style worksheet that results in a "wordy" exam style question.
Who is right?	Similar to the Whodunnit activity – usually comprises of 2 documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Data sheet. This can be used as a stand-alone worksheet or used in conjunction with worksheet 2. 2. Student worksheet in which they have to evaluate statements made by 4 teachers.

Connect 4 - Wsheet	Student worksheet, in which they work in pairs (or individually) to connect 4 in the answer grid (not the question grid), which will mean that they have to answer questions of varying difficulty. It is self checking so that if the answer isn't in the grid the student must check their working.
MustShouldCould Wsheet	Worksheet that has 3 stages each building up in terms of difficulty. Students to then either work straight down doing Q1 of each type or across when they want, or feel that they need to practice. You could also ask them as a class to write on a mini whiteboard where they are and they respond with Must 1c, Should 3b so you can see at a glance where the whole class is.
Top Trumps	Differentiated top trumps cards with three different levels. They can be used in the traditional way of Top Trumps or additional ideas are included.
Boarding Cards	A quick exercise to assess prior knowledge before starting each of the Super 60 topics.
Homeworks	A consistent style of homework across all 60 topics that included an element of literacy, practice and research.
Codebreakers	These worksheets include some progression in terms of difficulty where the students have to work out the solutions to the questions and then cross reference this to the key to spell out a phrase.
